FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Can I apply if I have Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status? *Answer:* Yes, if you are either attending school or have a permanent address in Western Washington, you are eligible to apply.
- Can I apply if I am a WW-NAHN member, but do not have a permanent address in Western WA, and am taking an online degree course in another state? *Answer:* Yes, WW-NAHN members are automatically eligible to apply for a scholarship.
- Do I need to send transcripts from all the schools I have attended? *Answer:* You only need to send in **current** college transcripts that include nursing courses and/or any prerequisites.
- Do I need to send official transcripts? *Answer:* An official transcript is not needed, an unofficial transcript is sufficient and needs to be submitted with the application.
- Do you have a form for my references to complete? *Answer:* No, we do not have a form. We prefer to have the reference write a letter of recommendation.
- Can I have a past instructor write a letter of recommendation? *Answer:* Yes, as long as they know you well enough to write a letter of recommendation.
- How do I send in the reference letter? *Answer:* Please ask your reference to submit your recommendation with your name in the subject line directly to: wnahn@uw.edu no later than the September 5 deadline.
- Which category of scholarship should I apply for? *Answer:* Please review the detailed information on the scholarship application to determine your category.
- Can I apply for a scholarship if I haven't completed any prerequisites? *Answer:* No, you need to complete the nursing prerequisites and be accepted and enrolled into a program before you can apply.
- How can I deliver my application? *Answer:* Please submit your application electronically to our email address: wnahn@uw.edu. September 5 deadline. We cannot accept faxes.
